1. What words or phrases from this scripture passage resonated in you as you read them? Why?
2. What is one practical step you sense God calling you to take in light of this message and/or scripture passage?
3. Do you find yourself running from God? Why are you running? What is the Holy Spirit calling you to do?
4. Who do you have difficulty showing grace to? Why? What do your feelings teach you about you?
5. How is God calling you to repent in light of this message? What are some practical steps you can take to walk in that repentance?

Application Question:

1. How did your family show grace to those they didn't like? Did you grow up in a home that made it easy or difficult to show love and compassion to those you didn't like?

Sermon Summary

Grace: God's underserved goodness to us. This grace is impartial, given to all. We like it when grace comes to us but have a very difficult time when grace comes to those we don't like. Rich reminds us this week that God is a God who pursues all and asks us to repent.
