5. How is God inviting you to "walk the ruins" of your community? What is Jesus inviting you to do?

Application Question

1. How did your family do conversations about the brokenness in your neighborhood? Did you grow up in a home that made it easy or difficult to be aware of the troubles in the neighborhood?
